



VISIT HIGHLIGHTS

Hut 11A: The Bombe Breakthrough

A permanent exhibition that tells the story of the Bombe machines in the actual location that housed the machines which broke Enigma. Includes a working model of a Bombe machine.

It explains in detail the challenges posed by Enigma and explores how Alan Turing, Gordon Welchman and others devised a machine to help solve it. Using the museum's Oral History archive and historic objects, it also considers how this contribution to the success of Allied signals intelligence had a significant impact on the course of WW2.

D-DAY: INTERCEPTION, INTELLIGENCE, INVASION

Opens spring 2019

This new exhibition will feature an immersive film and pre-show display to visitors in Spring 2019 to mark the 75th anniversary of the D-Day landings. This exciting audio-visual experience, **D-Day: Interception, Intelligence, Invasion** will be located in the newly restored Teleprinter Building.

Presenting the vital role Bletchley Park played in informing the D-Day invasion, the exhibition will introduce the people involved and show how different kinds of intelligence were used by the Allies to enable the invasion of Normandy on 6 June 1944 with precise detail.

VISITING BLETCHLEY PARK

RECOMMENDED VISIT TIME

There is lots to see and do at Bletchley Park so we recommend 3 to 5 hours for a visit. Please note that the entry tickets included in your group package are annual tickets, so you are welcome to return as many times as you wish within a year of your first visit date.

GUIDED TOURS

All visitors have the chance to register for a one-hour outdoor walking tour. These public guided tour tickets cannot be pre-booked.

MULTIMEDIA GUIDE

The multimedia guide at Bletchley Park is offered to all visitors, free of charge and there is an adult tour or family tour.

EATING AND DRINKING

A variety of food options are available onsite and include Hut 4 café, visitor centre coffee shop, seasonal snack kiosk and tea room in the Mansion.

PARKING

Coach parking: Pre-booked coaches are welcome to drop-off and pick-up on-site at scheduled times. We offer free off-site coach parking at Stadium MK. Please contact Group Bookings to book your collection/drop-off time.

Car parking: Limited, free on-site parking available for cars however car parking cannot be reserved.
